- Demonstrates commitment to Vision Zero values
- Helps build health and safety culture within your organisation
- Winners widely promoted across industry

WHO CAN ENTER?

To submit an entry for either award your company must be a member of MPA. It is assumed that the nomination will be made by the employee's line manager or someone more senior within the organisation.

Individual Recognition nominees and short-listed Young Leader entries will feature during the 2024 online MPA Health & Safety event. This provides an ideal opportunity for companies to celebrate their nomination and ensure wider industry recognition for their employees achievements.

YOUNG LEADER

- Based on nominations from companies for employees under 30 years of age on the 31st December 2023. There were 16 nominations in 2022
- The judges will review the entries and select finalists. You may be contacted by a judge to discuss your nomination. The winner/s will be selected from a short list of finalists.
