Deputy health and safety officer, Ian Rayner, made an initial sketch of a tool, acting as an extending arm, which can be used to move the idler from the safety of the walkway. This was then developed by other employees into a prototype and tested in the workshop. The process now involves: L raising the belt using a tool that straddles the conveyor L hooking the idler tool onto the far-side idler support bracket L sliding the new idler along the three props L raising the new idler into position using the tool. **ARTICLE IMAGES**
