Discharge doors on hot storage bins

ACCIDENT / INCIDENT DETAILS

On the 10th February 2003 a Fitter working on the Via Nova Asphalt Plant to free up the discharge doors on the hot storage bin No3 injured his finger and will be off work for a considerable period of time.

A full investigation is in progress to determine the cause of the incident but it would appear to have been caused when a piece of box section being used as a prop between the two doors fell out trapping the fitter's fingers between the doors.

LEARNING POINTS / ACTIONS TAKEN

Signs are going to be placed on the access to the working area of the face instructing all equipment to stop and contact the Cat 992 operators that they are about to enter their working area. Unless it is essential that you access this area whilst the machines are working then you should keep out of the hazardous area in front of the crusher.
