* Screwmen, when monitoring surface

the rear of the planer with the machine travelling away from them.

* Planer operators & supervisors are to be aware of the screwman[™]s position

when checking levels.

* Feet, or any other body part, must not,

under any circumstances, be placed in

front of the tracks of a planer or

similar machines, even if at rest.
