Quarries utilise drone technologies for multiple reasons.

Drone flights may occur here daily and at any time.

The management of this site has a legal responsibility for the safety of anyone who enters the site boundary. Should you wish to fly the drone over the site, we ask you to work with the site management team to ensure the flight is safe, successful and all risks are assessed and controlled.

We ask you to ensure you are following the Drone and Model Aircraft Code.

You must have insurance for activities other than fun, recreational, sport or hobby but you are still liable for any injury or damage you may cause.

Article 241. - 'A person must not recklessly or negligently cause or permit an aircraft to endanger any person or property.'

Deploying and flying in airspace already being used by site operations could be a breach of 241 and reportable to the Civil Aviation Authority
