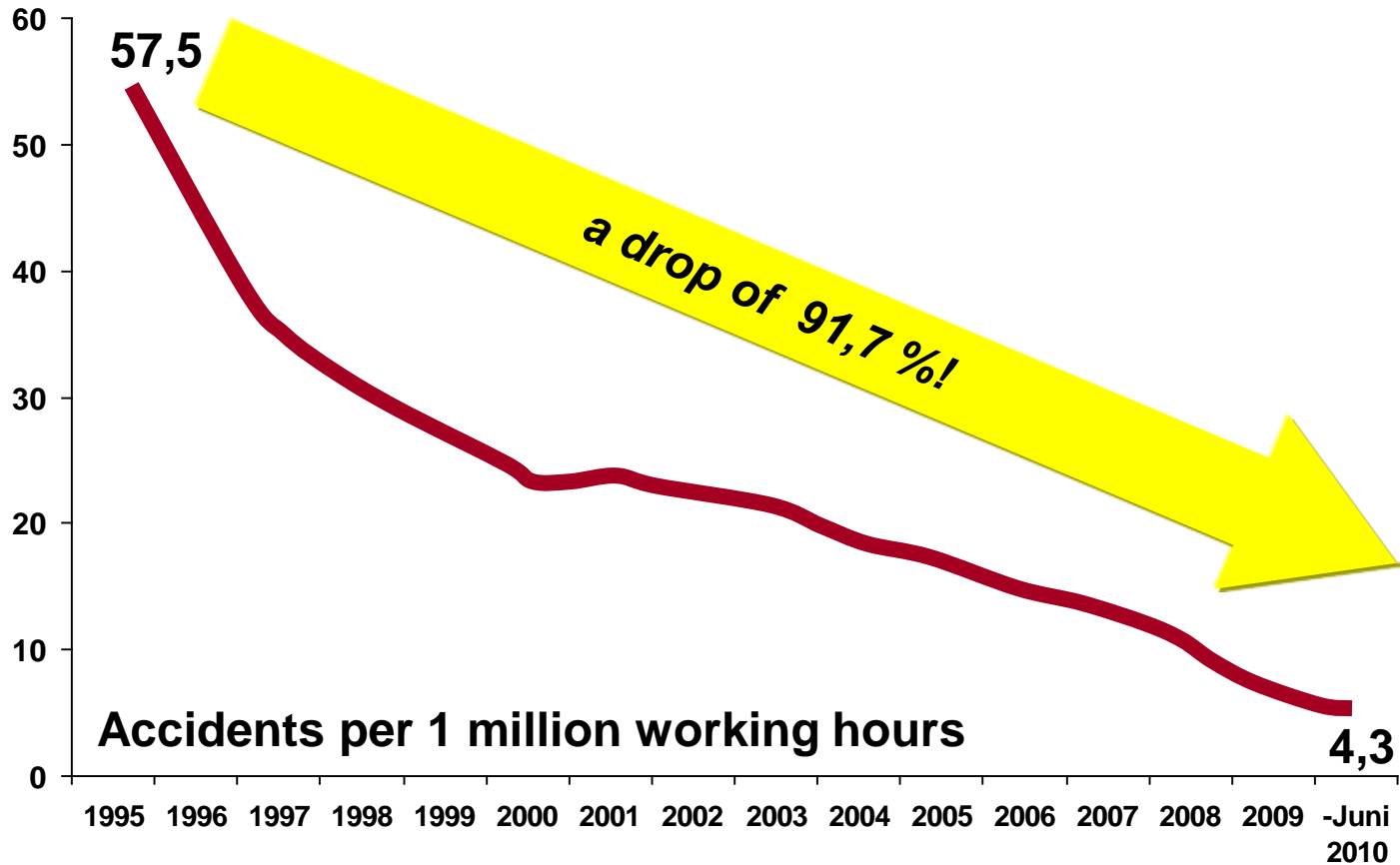

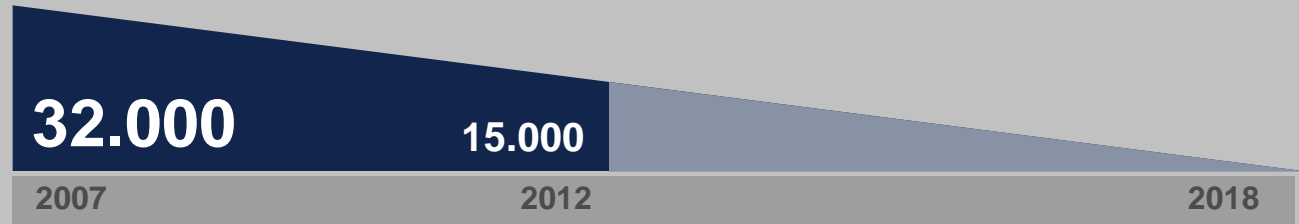
### Reduction of the production capacity in million tonnes by 2012

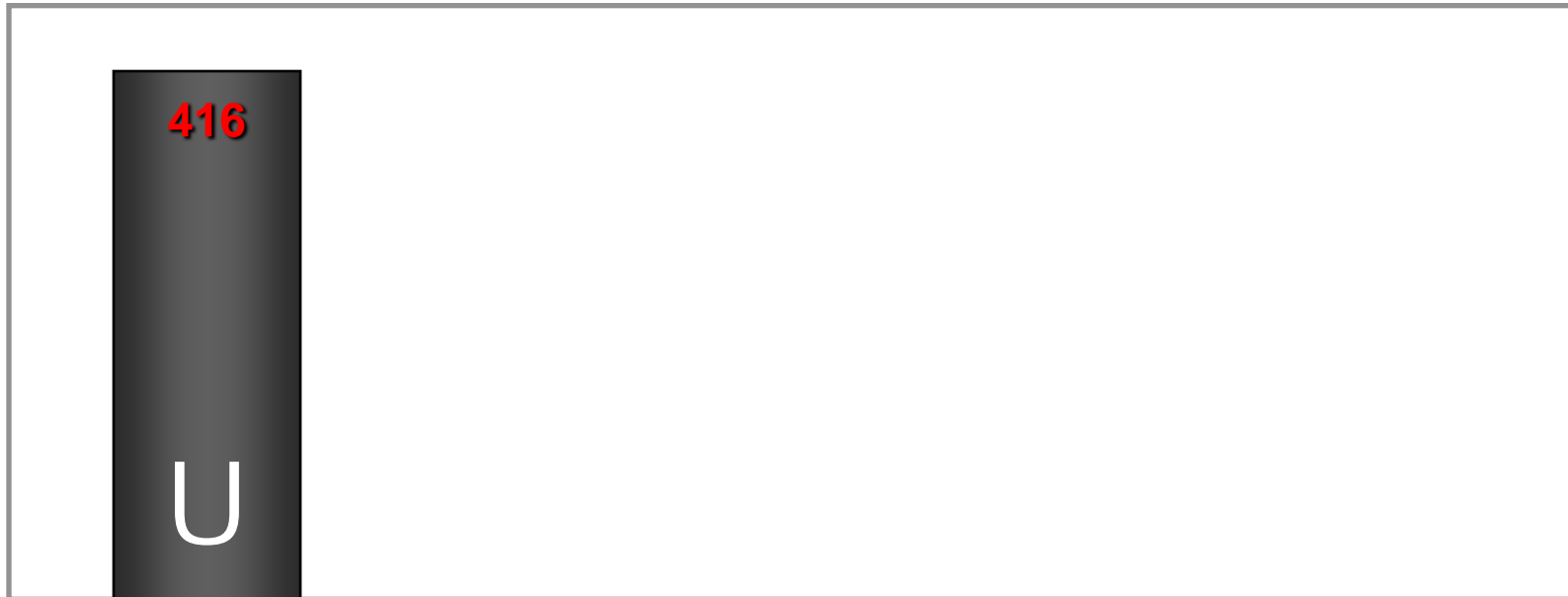


### Change in the number of mines by 2012



### Change in staff numbers by 2012



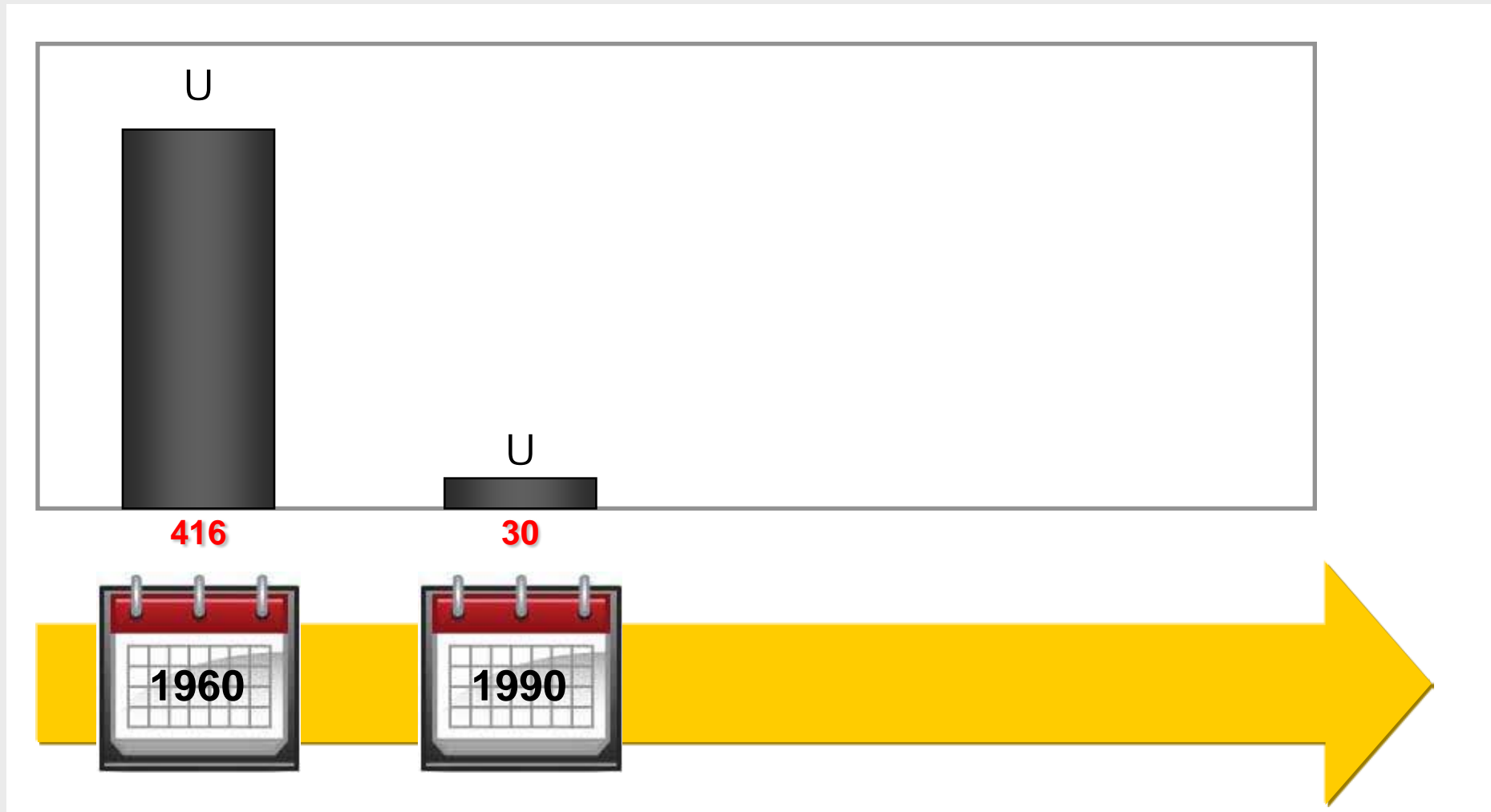

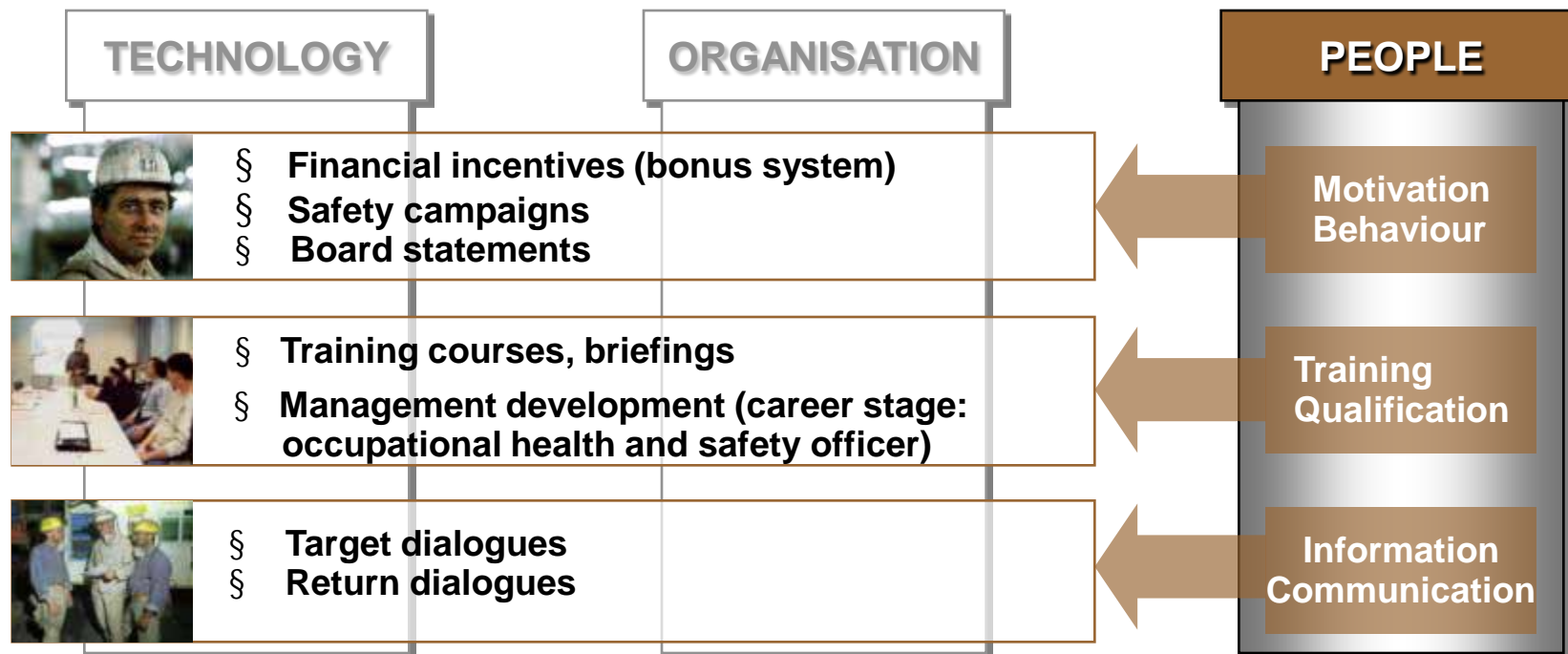
In a second step, organisational measures were introduced as a focus of the safety initiative



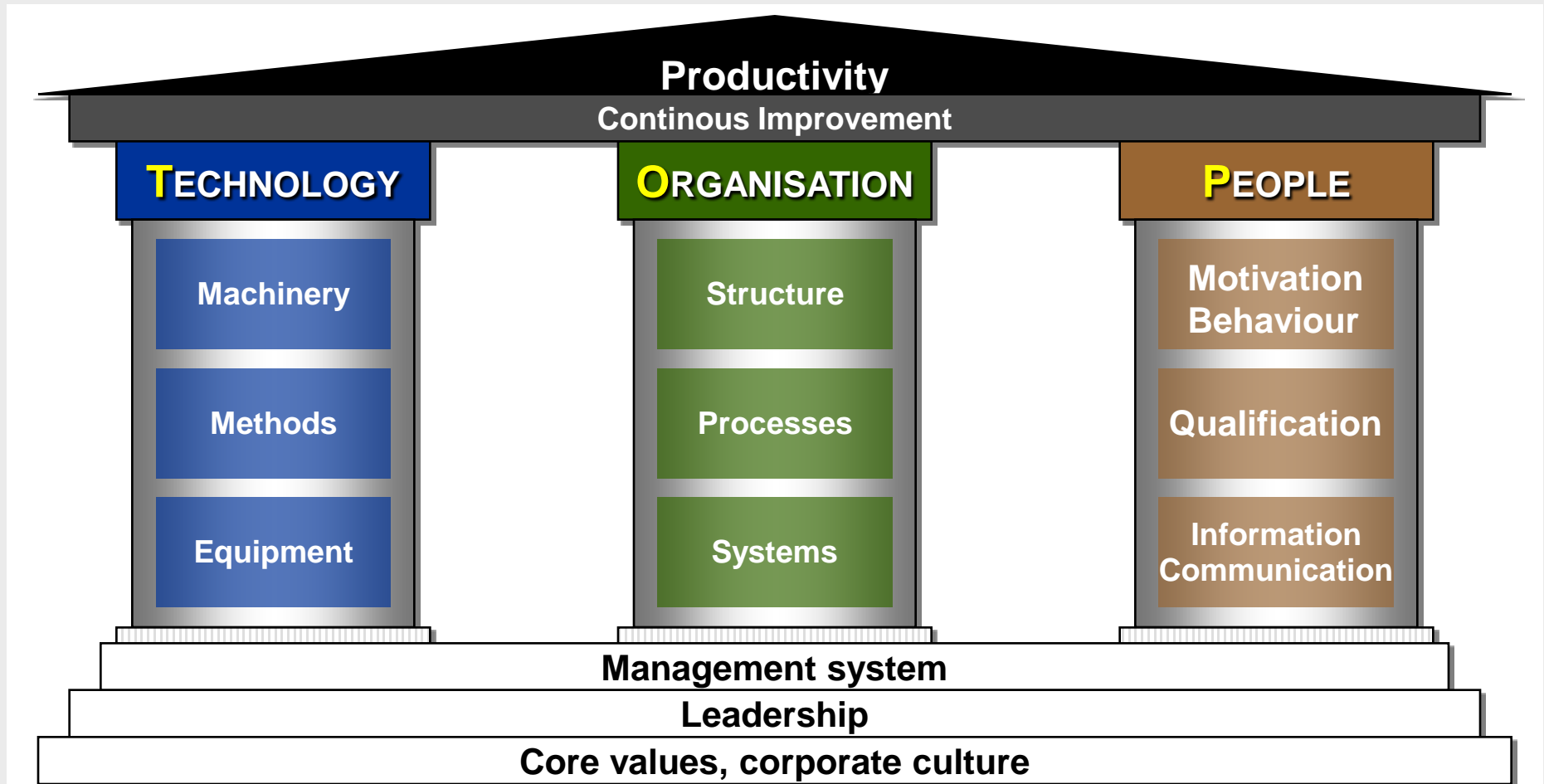




In a third step, employee-related measures were introduced as a focus of the safety initiative

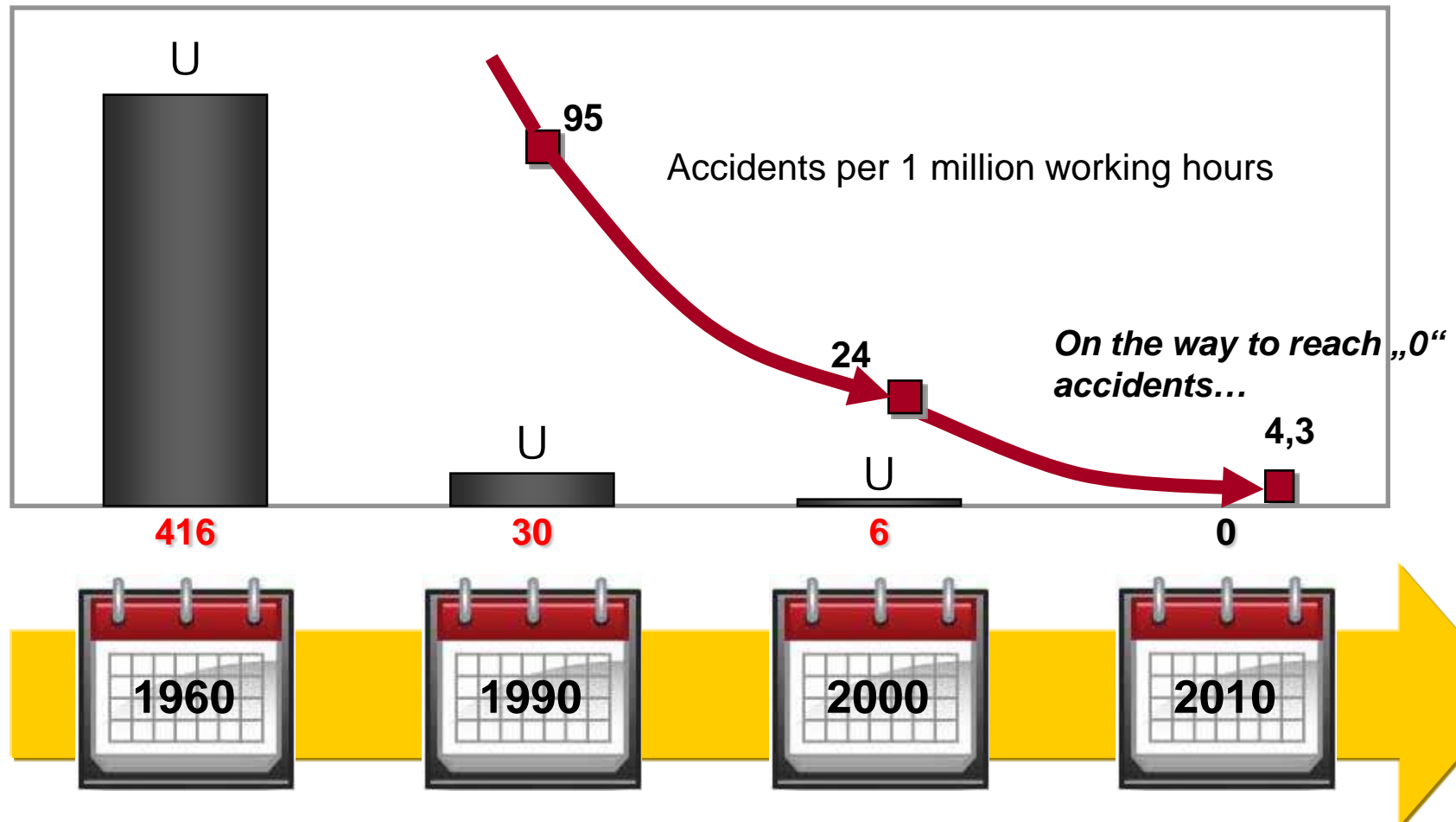


The success based on three pillars – the „TOP-model“ in our company
