










Occupational Diseases - Suspected Cases




Occupational Diseases - Top 7 of Suspected Cases














Company Sizes in Relation to Full Time Employees
















3 Causes for the New Approach








Illness in the Extractive Industry

Results of the Health Report


Diseases of the cardiovascular and the muscular and sceletal system occur very often in the extractive industry.


They are long-term illnesses and an important cost factor.

Causes:

- Lifting and carrying
- Non ergonomical working position
- Lack of exercise and activity
- **Consumption of alcohol and nicotine**
- Unhealthy nutrition and overweight
- Stress and insecure job situation




